ORDINANCE NO. 17

DIPLOMA COURSES

(Refer Sections 7(vi) and 35(b),(c) and (e) of the Act.)

(For the purpose of this Ordinance, the Act means Maharshi Panini Sanskrit Evam Vedic Vishwavidyalaya Adhiniyam 2006 (15 of 2008))

Title of the course

- (a) This ordinance entitled 'Diploma Courses' shall apply to regular courses of study and University examination leading to 'Diploma' in any subject and in any faculty.

Name of the faculty

- (b) Diploma course can be conducted in any subject and in any faculty by any of the University Teaching Departments.

Diploma courses shall be as follows :-

- (i) Diploma in spoken sanskrit and grammar
- (ii) Diploma in karmakand
- (iii) Diploma in practical jyotirvigyan
- (iv) Diploma in vastu vigyan

Diploma courses in other subjects shall be approved by the Executive Council, as and when required.

Duration of course

3. The duration of Diploma course in any subject and in any faculty shall be one academic year, generally starting from the month of July.

Eligibility

4. The minimum qualification for admission to diploma courses shall be Higher Secondary (10+2) or Uttar Madhyama or equivalent examination.

Provided that higher minimum qualifications may be prescribed by the Executive Council if the nature of the particular Diploma course so requires.

Admission procedure

5. The candidate shall apply on prescribed application form for admission. The admission shall be on merit basis as decided on the basis of the marks at the qualifying examination.

Provided that the admission for a particular Diploma course may be through a written entrance test, if it is so decided by the Kulpati

Total number of seats

6. The number of seats in each diploma course shall be decided separately by the Executive Council.

Fee structure

7. Same fees shall be chargeable as charged from M.A./Acharya students in the University Teaching Departments.

At present the fees are as follows :

- (i) Tuition fees Rs. 1200 (for boys) / Rs. 975 (for girls)
- (ii) Other fees Rs. 550
- (iii) Library caution money (refundable) Rs.500.

The fee structure shall be automatically revised whenever the fees for M.A./Acharya is revised. Provided that different fee structure may be approved by the Executive Council for any particular Diploma course, but in no case the fees shall be less than that for M.A./Acharya courses.

Provided further that if a regular student of M.A./Acharya in a University Teaching Department is allowed take admission in a diploma course also, then he/she shall not be charged any fees.

Provided also that if a teacher in the University Teaching Department is allowed to take admission in a diploma course, then he/she shall not be charged any fees, but he/she has to obtain permission of Kulpati in this respect.

Eligibility of diploma

8. A student shall be eligible for a diploma when he/she has passed the University examination for that diploma.

Examination, curriculum and rules**9. (1) University examination**

The pattern of University examination for a Diploma course in any subject and in any faculty shall be as follows :

		Total marks
(i)	Theory papers – four – each of 100 marks	400
(ii)	Practical examinations – two – each of 100 marks	200
	Total	600

- (a) Passing marks shall be 36% in theory and practical examinations separately.
- (b) No division or grade shall be awarded. The candidates shall be declared either pass or fail.
- (c) There will be no revaluation of answer books. Only re-totaling of marks in answer books of theory papers shall be allowed as per the rules of the University for semester examinations.
- (d) The distribution of marks in each of the two practical examinations shall be as follows :

(i)	Practical examination	60
(ii)	Internal assessment (CCE)	20
(iii)	Viva-voce examination	20
	Total	100

In the foils/counter foils only the total of the marks awarded out of 100 marks shall be shown for each practical examination, the distribution of marks shall not be shown.

- (e) The practical examinations shall be conducted by internal and/or external examiners as may be decided by the Kulpati.

(2) Syllabus

The syllabus of the four theory papers and the two practical examinations shall be prescribed for a Diploma course in any subject shall be as prescribed by the subject committee of that subject.

(3) Rules

The examination rules shall be the same as for annual system of examination of the University, except that there will be no revaluation of answer books.

Reservation of seats

10. Reservation of seats shall be as per rules of state government for degree/post graduate courses.

General instructions and provisions

11. For all matters not covered in this ordinance, the rules mentioned in other concerned ordinances of the University shall be applicable. In matters not covered in the ordinance or in other ordinances, the matter shall be decided by the Kulpati and his decision shall be final.

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
